## Westlands County Primary School, Chelmsford



The project consisted of 5 programmed phases spread throughout the school. The work content varied considerably from the formation of a new all weather sports field to new build class bases, school hall, refurbished kitchen and the remodelling of areas to form teaching and administration areas to the replacement of windows and external doors and screens throughout.

Successful completion of the project can be attributed to good coordination and solving the many logistical problems within the school. The contract called for work to be carried out in every classroom and admin area internally and 75% of the playground and parking areas externally. After careful consideration and consultation with the head teacher the phases were re-organised to allow both ourselves and the school to operate freely ensuring the construction activities on site did not interfere with maintaining a safe environment, conducive to teaching young children.

Construction methods included steel framing to the larger buildings and traditional brick and block to smaller sections. Particular emphasis was placed on prefabricated elements to enable the programme to be maintained.
