

DINING HALL & KITCHEN REFURBISHMENT



This project involved internal remodelling and refurbishment of the schools dining hall and kitchen area.

We extended and remodelled the kitchen, which included a full electrical and mechanical strip out and install. Infilling the dropped floor in the hall and refurbishing the area as a dining room. Including the infill of the sunken courtyard to provide level access out of the dining hall and to the surrounding site, as well as addressing drainage and flood issues.

An acoustic ceiling was laid and spaced to accommodate strip LED lighting and ventilation needs. The hexagon sound absorbing tiles were hung individually allowing the backdrop of a painted roof to be visible from below. A new fire and security alarm was installed which had to integrate with the school's existing system.
