Sustainable procurement is embedded into our management system through supplier and subcontractor evaluation.

T. J. Evers Ltd is committed to ensuring that it:

- Use only timber from legal and sustainable sources such as that certified under the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) scheme or PEFC (The Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification) and the Sustainable Forestry Initiatives (SFI), with full Chain of Custody to ensure that timber-based materials are produced to the highest ecological, social and ethical standards.
- Avoid the use of material and substances with hazardous properties, and processes which could cause damage to health or the environment.
- Maximise the use of materials with recycled content, or materials that can be easily recycled at the end of their useful life.

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- Assess the sustainable credentials and performance of our Supply Chain.
- Monitor and measure our use of sustainable materials through BREEAM as appropriate.
- Use a local Supply Chain wherever possible to minimise the environmental impact associated with transportation and to supply the local economy.

Evers recognises that it can contribute to a more sustainable future and will implement this Procurement Policy as part of our overall sustainability strategy.
